

**Olympia Community School Drama Camp
Behavior Agreement
July 2010**

Please review this agreement with your child. Both the parent/guardian and child must sign the agreement and turn it in to the director before the first day of camp.

Our goal for OCS Drama Camp is for each child to have fun, try new activities, learn new skills, experience their unique selves, explore their creativity, collaborate with peers, and take responsibility for themselves.

These goals are best accomplished if each child and parent/guardian understands that camp participants are expected to:

- Participate fully in the camp. This includes arriving on time, prepared and ready to work. Preparation may include writing, recording or imagining stories, learning parts, bringing in costume pieces or props as requested, or other activities.
- Follow requests made by the staff.
- Cooperate with staff and with other students.
- Stay in camp rehearsal area- do not wander off.
- Treat everyone with respect.
- Maintain the OCS space by keeping it clean.

We expect that children learn to manage their own behavior. If necessary we will:

- Discuss any negative behavior with the child and develop solutions. If the problem persists, we will
- Discuss the problem with parent(s) and notify both parent(s) and child that further problems will result in dismissal.
- If these actions do not adequately address the problem, dismissal may be necessary.

If at any time the child presents a danger to him/her self or others the parent/guardian will be called and the child will be dismissed from drama camp.

We have read and understand this behavior agreement.
